ORDER REGARDING HEARING ON DECEMBER 17, 2018

On November 21, 2018, the Court-appointed special master filed her report and recommendation concerning the initial allocation of the Court's attorney fee award, awards of expenses, and service awards. Eleven objections to the report and recommendation were filed. The Court has scheduled a hearing on those objections on December 17, 2018, which will also be considered a hearing before the Hon. Laurie Miller and the Hon. David Herndon.

At the hearing, the judges may first ask the special master to address particular matters raised in the objections. The Court will then hear argument from attorneys who filed objections to the report and recommendation and notices of their intent to appear, with argument limited to ten (10) minutes per objection. No one who has not filed a written objection will be entitled to present argument. Co-lead and settlement class counsel (who filed a notice of intent to appear) will then be granted up to 30 minutes in which to respond to any objections. If the Court desires any further argument, it will so indicate at the hearing.
