1. The hearing will take place in **courtroom #643**, located on the 6th Floor, Robert J. Dole United States Courthouse, 500 State Avenue, Kansas City, Kansas, on March 30, 2016 beginning at 10:30 a.m. A telephone conference line will be available for interested counsel and parties to listen in on this hearing. Participants on the phone line will NOT be able to participate in the hearing, only listen in. Participants will follow the instructions to join the call.

The court has previously set Non-Producer Counterclaim Defendants’ and Third Party Defendants’ Motions to Dismiss Syngenta’s Counterclaims and Third-Party Complaints (doc. 1434) and Non-Producer Counterclaim Defendant Rail Transfer, Inc.’s Motion to Dismiss Syngenta’s Counterclaims (doc. 1436) for oral argument on **March 30, 2016 at 10:30 a.m.** Time limits shall be as follows: movants shall

have not to exceed 25 minutes for their opening argument, to be divided between themselves; defendants shall have not to exceed 40 minutes to respond; and movants shall have not to exceed 15 minutes for their rebuttal argument, to be divided between themselves.

3. The court will seek input from counsel concerning co-ordination with the ethanol cases filed in various state courts.
4. The court will also entertain any matters which counsel wish to bring to the court's attention.
