STANDING ORDER PERTAINING TO CM/ECF

Counsel shall comply with the rules and administrative procedures which implement this court's CM/ECF system. However, counsel and pro se parties shall provide one paper set of the following directly to chambers in addition to applicable e-filing requirements:

Civil Cases

1. All briefing relating to the following motions. Briefing for purposes of this order means the initial brief in support, a response, or a reply.
 - a. Applications for temporary restraining orders or preliminary injunctions;
 - b. Dispositive motions (motions to dismiss or for summary judgment);
 - c. Motions to remand;
 - d. Motions for change of venue;
 - e. Motions in limine;
 - f. Motions to reconsider.
2. Requested instructions; and
3. Trial briefs.

Criminal Cases

1. All briefing relating to the following motions:
 - a. Motions to dismiss;
 - b. Motions to suppress;
 - c. Motions to modify presentence investigation reports.
2. Requested instructions; and
3. Trial briefs.
