Waivable Case Compensation Maximums for Non-Capital Cases (CJA 20).

(Note that there are no statutory attorney case compensation maximums for capital cases. See CJA Guidelines 630.10.20).

Section (d)(2) of the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. §3006A, provides that the attorney case compensation maximums increase simultaneously by the aggregate percentage increases in the maximum hourly non-capital rate, rounded to the nearest \$100.

Capital Cases (CJA 31):

For all capital cases, the compensation maximum amounts for investigative, expert, and other services set forth in the CJA Guidelines 310.20.10 are inapplicable. In death penalty cases (federal capital prosecutions and capital post-conviction proceedings), the case maximum with prior authorization is governed by a separate statute, 18 U.S.C. §3599(g)(2), which provides an amount of \$7500.00 for the fees and expenses of **all** investigative, expert, and other service providers combined rather than an amount for each individual services provider. If it can be anticipated that the payments for investigative, expert, and other services will exceed the statutory maximum, advanced approval should be obtained from the court and the circuit.
