- 3. Motions to remand, responses and replies;
- 4. Motions for change of venue, responses and replies;
- 5. Motions in limine, responses and replies;
- 6. Motions to reconsider, responses and replies;
- 7. Requested instructions; and
- 8. Trial briefs.

Criminal Cases

- 1. Motions to dismiss, responses and replies;
- 2. Motions to suppress, responses and replies;
- 3. Requested instructions; and
- 4. Trial briefs.
