## <u>ORDER</u>

By Memorandum and Order of December 31, 2018, the Court allocated \$246,633,333.33 from the total attorney fee award in this case to the Kansas MDL common benefit pool. The Court hereby grants the request of MDL co-lead counsel that they be designated to divide this allocation among the attorneys that the Court assigned to this pool (as originally proposed in the special master's report and recommendation). In making that determination, co-lead counsel shall comply with the strictures and principles set forth in the Memorandum and Order concerning common benefit work. Co-lead counsel shall

discuss their proposed division with the attorneys in this pool and shall attempt to resolve

any disputes. On or before February 1, 2018, co-lead counsel shall file with the Court a

report and recommendation concerning their proposed division. On or before **February** 

15, 2018, attorneys in this pool shall file any responses or objections to co-lead counsel's

report and recommendation. Co-lead counsel shall file any reply brief on or before

February 22, 2018. The Court will then make the final awards of fees to attorneys in this

pool.
