**STANDING ORDER**

This Standing Order applies to any habeas case filed in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 in which the petitioner seeks relief relating to immigration proceedings or detention by immigration officials, and in which no federal official or entity has been named as a respondent. In any such case, the acting or current Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the acting or current Director of Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) shall be permitted to intervene as respondents under Fed. R. Civ. P. 24 (a)(2) and (b)(2), without the need for such officials to file a motion to intervene, for the reasons set forth by the Court in its order granting a motion to intervene in *Kurbanov v. Warden*, No. 26-3159 (June 26, 2026). Those officials shall be added as respondents by the Court in the caption and record of any such case.

This order will remain in effect until further order of the Court.
